What is Baptism?

1. What do you think baptism is? (Answer: Baptism is an outward expression of an inward change. Being dunked in the water is a way to remember Jesus' death and resurrection. Because we are also dead to sin and raised to new life in Christ. This is a public testimony of your faith in Jesus.)
2. Who can be baptized? (Answer: Anyone who has believed in Jesus as their Savior can and should be baptized.)
3. Why do you want to be baptized? (Answer: To obey God and follow Him. To let others know you want to follow Jesus with your life.)
4. When do you get baptized? (Answer: Once you have believed in Jesus as Savior, you can do it anytime.)
5. What happens when you get baptized? (Answer: The Pastor, parent, or leader will help you into the water, he may ask you a question about your belief in Jesus, and then he will say, I baptize you in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. He will then lean you backward and dunk you under the water. You did it! You have followed Jesus' example and are a witness to what He has done for you!

What is Baptism?

(Answer: The Pastor, parent, or leader will help you into the water, he may ask you a question about your belief in Jesus, and then he will say, I baptize you in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. He will then lean you backward and dunk you under the water. You did it! You have followed Jesus' example and are a witness to what He has done for you!
